Student ambassadors represent the University of Exeter and work with staff in the Student Recruitment Office to support recruitment and widening participation events.

Examples of work available:

- Working at university **open days** and **offer-holder visit days**
- Manning stands or giving talks at **information fairs** in schools and colleges across the country
- Supporting the delivery of **workshops** for young people aged 13-18
- **Mentoring** young people in local schools regarding higher education
- Working as an **AccessAbility and Wellbeing** ambassador
- Providing **subject tutoring** for young people in local schools
- Running **campus tours**
- Working on **residential**s
- There may also be the opportunity to work directly for your university school/college on **subject-related events**

Hours: Work is available for student ambassadors throughout the year. Student Ambassadors can put

their name forward for as much or as little work as they feel able to commit to around their studies; but they are expected to commit to work on a regular basis.

Pay: £7.85 per hour. All travel costs and time are covered.
