

Under the Umbrella

A fun, interactive training experience designed to help teachers and school staff better understand and support neurodivergent children.

What is involved?

You will be guided through a series of short tasks which are designed to mirror parts of the school day. The tasks will be tweaked to give a small taste of what some neurodivergent children may experience.

Important information

- A 2 and a half hour training slot with 2 facilitators can train up to 48 staff*
- You will need to provide space for the training (e.g. a classroom or school hall), tables and chairs
- You will be asked to provide some on the day feedback
- We may also ask a few staff for a quick follow up conversation after a few months.

*exact numbers will depend on space available



What will you get for taking part?

- A better understanding of challenges experienced by neurodivergent children.
- Suggestions of simple ways to make these challenges a little easier!
