Parking

Visitors are able to park in Car Park C and 15 spaces in Car Park A, on a pay and display basis, by using the parking app 'Pay by Phone' and subject to availability.

All other car parks will require a parking permit to park. Please speak to your event manager regarding permits. Please note that all University of Exeter permits are not valid on the Prince of Wales Road and Streatham Drive on the Streatham Campus, both of which are Council operated parking zones.

Public Transport

Bus/Coach – The Streatham & St Lukes Campuses are served by Stagecoach line 4 University service. From Monday to Saturday and connects Streatham Campus – Exeter Central railway station – City Centre – Central Bus Station – St Luke's Campus, every 12 minutes.

Rail - Exeter's two mainline railway stations are Exeter St David's and Exeter Central. Exeter St James is also within walking distance of both campuses. Streatham campus is a 15-minute walk from St David's station, 15-minute walk from St James station and 20 minutes from Exeter Central station. The walking route is signed from St David's' station and the campus map shows the walking route.

Electric Vehicle Charging

The nearest electric charging bays are installed in Car park B. There are 30 bays, marked in green and available to any permit holders with an e-mail address (which includes third parties working on our campus) and pre-arranged visitors. The electric charging bays are provided by an external company called Pod Point and are managed through their app.

Accessibility

The Peter Chalk Centre is fully accessible.

Lift

There are no lifts in the Peter Chalk Centre, all rooms are accessible from the ground floor.

Fire Safety

The Fire Alarm in The Forum is a continuous ringing siren; the system is tested weekly on a Wednesday around 09:30am. If the alarm sounds for longer than 10 seconds or at any other time, please listen carefully to the voice message and make your way to your nearest safe emergency exit and proceed to your nearest assembly point, as directed by the Fire Marshall's.

IF YOU DISCOVER A FIRE raise the alarm by activating the nearest Break Glass Unit.

- On the opposite side of Stocker Road, on the grassed area outside The Northcott Theatre
- Outside of the Physics building
