Call for Abstracts

The Sixth UCL-KCL Environmental Law Symposium will be held at King's College London on **Friday 19 May 2023**. Continuing the tradition of this conference, the Symposium provides the opportunity for early researchers (MPhil, PhD and postdoctoral researchers) to share and discuss ideas and work in the area of environmental law and policy broadly conceived with peers and faculty chairs. The symposium is held with the support of the Centre for Law and the Environment (UCL), the Climate Law and Governance Research Centre (KCL), the Transnational Law Institute (KCL) and the London Arts and Humanities Partnership (LAHP).

The Symposium welcomes contributions covering a wide array of areas, including, but not limited to, treatments of:

- Climate-change-related law and/or policy;
- Environmental justice;
- International environmental law and policy;
- Comparative environmental law and policy;
- Theoretical, normative or methodological interventions;
- Interdisciplinary work, drawing on the social sciences, environmental sciences, humanities, and beyond.
