★What is a study?

A study is what you do when you want to find out something new or learn more about something. You might have already done a study in science! In this study, we want to find out about what helps you to learn at school.

★Why is a study being done at my school?

We are doing a study called Tools for School to find out if we can help teachers to teach better.

★Why me?

Your teachers think that this study might help you with your learning and make learning at school more fun.



★What happens to me/my class if I take part?

You will go to school and learn in your class. Some new people may come in to learn with you and watch your classroom when the teacher is teaching.

You might be asked by your teacher to try something new or leave the classroom to do more learning in a different room.

You will be asked questions about what you like about school and what you do not like about school.

You will also be asked questions about your feelings.



★Will the study help me or not?

The study will try to make school more fun and interesting for you. You will get to try new things in class that will help you learn.



★What shall I do now?

Now you know about the study you need to think about if you want to take part in the study.

★Who can I ask about this?

You can talk to your parents, friends, teachers, Dr Abby (who made Tools for Schools) and anyone you trust, if you want to ask more questions.



★Do I have to say yes?

No – but if you do say yes now, you can change your mind whenever you like.

But remember your parents will make the last choice and tell you if you can or cannot take part in the study.
